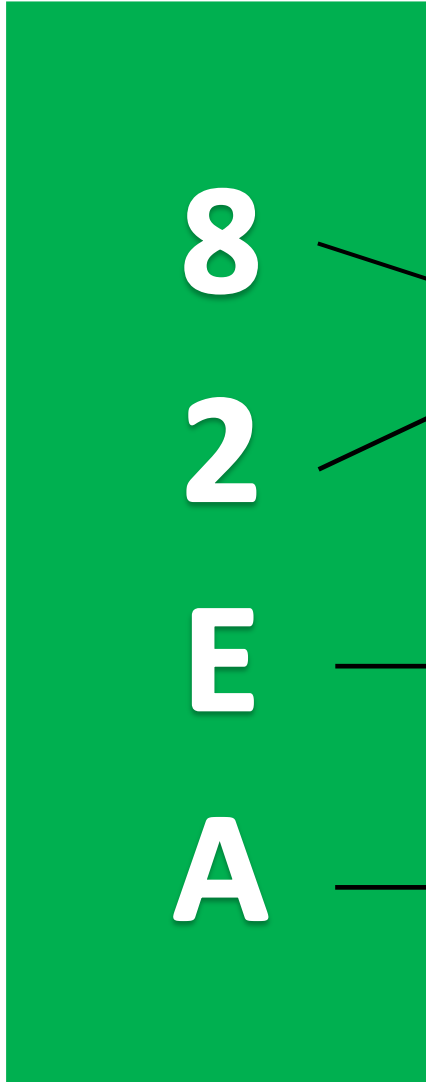


# EMERGENCY RESPONSE RAMP LABELING CONVENTION



The first two digits are the exit number.

Ex. Exit 82

Exit 82 is from I-4, Exit 10 is from SR 408

The first letter is the direction of travel.

E is for eastbound, W is for westbound

The last letter is for the ramp designation, where ramps split or bifurcate into 2 different branches.

Ex. Ramp A or Ramp B

The ramp label above would indicate Exit 82 from eastbound I-4, ramp A.

Ramp letter A will always be a westbound destination. So, in this case, it's Exit 82 eastbound from I-4, ramp A, which goes to 408 westbound.

Ramp letter B will always be an eastbound destination. 82EB would be Exit 82 from I-4 eastbound, ramp B, which goes to 408 eastbound.

The same pattern is used on 408, with exit 10.
